NSBL DEFAULT RULE TT.7

Only 1 player may be absent from a team. If a player is absent from one or both teams, the match will proceed but the Fours rink in the defaulting teams(s) will comprise only 3 players and the number of bowls will be made up by the Lead and Second players playing three bowls each. One third of the total shots scored by a defaulting rink will be deducted from its score and the score will be rounded down.

If more than 1 player is absent from the team or if a team is unable to commence play 30 minutes after the appointed start time, the match will be awarded to the Club not in default. If both teams are more than 1 player short, both Clubs will be eliminated from the competition. Rules G10 and G11 will apply to a defaulting Club.

NSBL MATCH ABANDONED RULE TT.10

If a match has to be abandoned, the score will be taken if a minimum of 14 ends have been played by each of the four rinks, or, in the case of the Singles, the game has finished. The score will be taken at the lowest number of ends played by all rinks. If the Singles has finished at the time the match is abandoned, its result will count irrespective of the number of ends played.

In the event of abandonment before the minimum number of ends have been played, the match will be played from its beginning on an immediate following weekend morning (i.e. Saturday or Sunday). The score at the point at which the match was abandoned will be discounted. If the Final is abandoned before the minimum number of ends have been played the result will be declared on the basis of the lowest number of ends played by any rink. Again, if the Singles has finished at the time of abandonment, its result will count irrespective of the number of ends played.
